8) Develop a precis and give a title to the following paragraph: The Ethics Committee was established on March 4, 1997, by the Chairman of the Rajya Sabha with the purpose of supervising and ensuring the moral and ethical behaviour of members. "Its role involves reviewing cases referred to it in relation to the ethical and other misconduct of members", the official website of Rajya Sabha noted. The members of the Ethics Committee are appointed by the speaker for a period of one year. According to a report by The Indian Express, any individual can file a complaint against a Member of Parliament (MP) by going through another Lok Sabha MP. This complaint should include supporting evidence of the alleged misconduct and an affidavit confirming that the complaint is not "false, frivolous, or vexatious." Meanwhile, the committee examines every complaint relating to unethical conduct of a member of Lok Sabha referred to it by the Speaker and makes such recommendations as it may deem fit. After a preliminary inquiry, if there is no prima facie case then, the matter might be dropped. The Committee submits its report to the Speaker, who then seeks the House's opinion on whether the report should be deliberated. Additionally, there is a provision for a 30-minute discussion on the report. Recently Nishikant Dubey complained against Mahua Moitra in a case of taking cash for asking questions in the Parliament allegedly designed to target the Adani Group

Develop a precis and give a title to the following paragraph: Ahead of Deepavali celebrations, Prime Minister Narendra Modi urged Indians to promote the "Vocal for Local" campaign and buy indigenous products in order to achieve the dream of Aatmnirbhar Bharat, or a self-sufficient India. During his monthly Mann Ki Baat address, Mr. Modi said that the ongoing Khadi Mahotsav had broken all its previous sales records. While sales had barely touched ₹30,000 crore in previous years, sales in this edition were about to reach ₹1.25 lakh crore, he said. "Benefiting from these sales are our weavers, handicraft artisans, our farmers, cottage industries engaged in growing Ayurvedic plants," the PM said, requesting his audience to buy products made by local artisans during their travels for tourism or pilgrimage. Asking them to illuminate their homes only with local products, he said that the "Vocal for Local" spirit should not be limited only to festival shopping, but also for all the necessities of life. "Today, India is becoming the world's biggest manufacturing hub. Many big brands are manufacturing their products here. If we adopt those products, then 'Make In India' gets a fillip... While buying such products, try to insist on the pride of our country, the UPI digital payment system," he added.
