- Explain, whether the vectors (1, -2, 1), (2, 1, -1) and (7, -4, 1) are linearly dependent or not.
- Find the value of constant  $\lambda$  , if the matrix  $\begin{pmatrix} \lambda & 1 & 2 \\ 0 & -1 & 5 \\ 2 & 0 & 1 \end{pmatrix}$  is singular (not invertible).
- 3) Find the value of 'k' for which the given set of equations has infinite solutions:

(3k-8) x + 3y + 3z = 0, 3x + (3k-8) y + 3z = 0,3x+3y+(3k-8)z = 0.

- Show that the polynomials 1, x and  $x^2$  span the vector space  $P_2(x)$ .
- By Gauss Jordan method, find the inverse of the matrix  $A = \begin{pmatrix} 1 & 2 & 3 \\ 3 & 5 & 6 \\ 2 & 4 & 5 \end{pmatrix}$ .
- Solve the system of equations :  $x_1 + x_2 + x_3 = 1.3x_1 + x_2 3x_3 = 5$  , K3 (9)  $x_1 2x_2 5x_3 = 10$  by Gauss elimination method.
- Examine the following system of equations for the unique solution by Gauss Jordan method: x y + 3z w = 1, y 3z + 5w = 2, x z + w = 0, x + 2z w = -5.
- Let the linear transformation T:  $\mathbb{R}^3 \to \mathbb{R}^3$  be defined by T(x, y, z) = (x + z, 2x + y + 3z, 2y + 2z). Then find the dimension of the range space and null space of T.

Investigate the values of a and b so that the system (12) 2x + 3y + 5z = 9,7x + 3y - 2z = 8,2x + 3y + az = b has (i) Unique solution (ii) No solution (iii) Infinite no. of solutions.
