Imagine you are Ram's advocate and have to explain what the rights of a coparcener are to Shyam. In light of the same, list out the rights of the coparcener. K2(6)

- 5) Parsis in India are governed by which laws for the purpose of their succession? Give Overview. K3(9)

- 7) Is 'Pran Pratishtha' necessary while making endowment of a Hindu Idol? K4(12)
- 8) Maya, a Hindu female, dies intestate, leaving behind her husband, Arjun, and her unborn child. Subsequently, the child is born alive. How would the inheritance be distributed between Arjun and the newborn child according to the Hindu Succession Act? - 10) Rajesh, a Hindu male, passes away intestate, leaving behind no immediate heirs from class I or class II of the Schedule outlined in the Hindu Succession Act.
