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Morning Assembly

Student-teacher ratio

Student-teacher ratio defines the average number of students per teacher at a specific level of education.

A high pupil-teacher ratio suggests that each teacher has to be responsible for a large number of pupils.

In other words, the higher the pupil-teacher ratio, the lower the relative access of pupils to teachers.

When in 'National Victor Public School', each class has more than 40 students and as a teacher, my observation says that it is not so easy to handle and cover all the students.

An important aspect to teaching is observation. When a teacher

has fewer students to observe, then smaller things can be quickly picked up on and if needed, acted upon.

So low student to teacher ratio is really important for a teacher to be more effective in his/her position.

Extra-Curricular Activities
